Subject: information and request for consent pursuant to and for all the purposes of Articles. 13, 23 and 26 of Legislative Decree No. 196 dated 30.06.2003 on the protection of personal data.

Legislative Decree No 196 of June 30, 2003 ("Code regarding the protection of personal data") provides that the processing of personal data is based on principles of correctness, lawfulness and transparency and protection of your privacy and your rights.

Under Article 13 of Legislative Decree No 196/2003, we provide you with the following information:

1. The information you provided will be used for the following purposes: processing and storage for the purpose of preparation of financial reports, processing and sending of statements (Unico, 730, VAT etc.), processing and management of administrative paperwork, accounting, administrative and legal advice; in order to manage every aspect of our contractual relationship

During such processing we could become aware of data that Legislative Decree 196/2003 defines "personal" as appropriate to detect, for example:

- health status or sexual habits;
- membership of a trade union;
- membership of a political party or movement;
- religious or philosophical beliefs.
- 2. The processing will be carried out with manual and/or automatic systems used to store, manage and transmit the data, with logics strictly related to the purposes listed in point 1).
- 3. The list of those responsible for data processing is available at our office located in Milan Via Parini 5/A, from 10.00 to 12.00 AM Mondays and Fridays.
- 4. The communication of data is mandatory in order to achieve the above purposes and the refusal to provide such data may lead to the non-execution and/or partial execution of the task assigned to us.
- 5. The list of those responsible for data processing in outsourcing is available at our office located in Milan Via Parini 5/A, from 10.00 to 12.00 AM Mondays and Fridays.
- 6. The scope of any possible data communication can be both national and European;
- 7. At any time you can exercise your rights under Art. 7 of Legislative Decree 196/2003, reproduced below:

Legislative Decree No. 196/2003, Art .7 - Right to Access Personal Data and Other Rights

- 1. You have the right to obtain confirmation of whether or not we hold personal data concerning yourself, even if not yet recorded, and their communication in legible form.
- 2. You have the right to obtain information about:
 - a) the origin of personal data;
 - b) the purposes and methods of processing;
 - c) the logic applied in the event processing is performed with the aid of electronic instruments;
 - d) the identity of the data processor and the representative appointed under article 5, paragraph 2;
 - e) the individuals or categories of individuals to whom such personal information may be communicated or who may learn of its content such as the designated representative in the national territory, managers, or assigned individuals.
- 3. You have the right to obtain:
 - a) updating, correction, or, if interested, integration of the data;
 - b) deletion, transformation, anonymization or the block of information processed in violation of the law, including that which does not need to be hold for the purposes for which the information was collected or subsequently processed;
 - c) certification that the operations set forth in points a) and b) have been made aware, including their contents, to those who have received the data, except for cases in which this obligation is impossible or would require means that are clearly disproportionate with respect to the protected right.
 - 4. You have the right to oppose, in whole or in part:
 - a) for legitimate reasons to the processing of personal data, even if pertinent to the purpose of collection;
 - a) to the processing of personal data for purposes of forwarding of advertising materials or direct selling or for carrying out market surveys or commercial communication.
